

MIX AND MATCH FACES

Look at each face and draw a line to a feeling word that you think matches. If there are any feelings that you don't think match up, draw what that face would look like in the blank faces!

The activity consists of 12 cartoon faces and 12 feeling words. The faces are arranged in a grid-like pattern, with some showing specific emotions and others being blank. The feeling words are scattered around the faces. The faces and their corresponding words are:

- Top-left: A smiling face with the word **HAPPY** above it.
- Top-middle: A blank face with the word **EXCITED** above it.
- Top-right: A blank face with the word **CURIOUS** above it.
- Middle-left: A face with a disgusted expression and the word **DISGUSTED** to its left.
- Middle-middle: A face with a proud expression and the word **PROUD** above it.
- Middle-right: A face with an angry expression and the word **ANGRY** to its right.
- Bottom-left: A face with a shocked expression and the word **SHOCKED** above it.
- Bottom-middle: A face with a disappointed expression and the word **DISAPPOINTED** above it.
- Bottom-right: A blank face with the word **ANNNOYED** to its right.
- Lower-middle: A face with a hopeful expression and the word **HOPEFUL** above it.
- Lower-right: A face with a frustrated expression and the word **FRUSTRATED** above it.
- Bottom-most: A face with a sad expression and the word **SAD** to its right.
- Far-left: A face with a jealous expression and the word **JEALOUS** to its left.
- Far-right: A face with an exhausted expression and the word **EXHAUSTED** above it.
- Bottom-most-left: A blank face with the word **CHEERFUL** below it.
- Bottom-most-right: A face with a confused expression and the word **CONFUSED** below it.
